



# Level 2 Supply Chain Warehouse Operative

## End-Point Assessment

### About the End-Point Assessment

The broad purpose of the occupation is to handle goods safely in and out of storage facilities. This will involve the unloading of goods from lorries, trains, ships or planes, the identification and checking of the product and then putting it away in a storage location. Operatives will pick products from storage locations to satisfy customer orders. Some products may require repackaging prior to assembly for despatch.

Warehouse Operatives will typically work in large buildings and often have a shift working pattern in order to provide a twenty-four-hour operation. A driving licence is not an absolute necessity but may be preferable for access to Distribution Centres, located on out-of-town industrial estates where public transport may not be available for shift start and finish times.

### Gateway Requirements

The apprentice must have achieved Level 1 English and maths qualifications, where applicable (in line with funding rules)

Apprentices must submit a Portfolio of Evidence to support the Interview.

Typical duration to Gateway: 12 months.

### The Assessment

The apprentice will be assessed against the Supply Chain Warehouse Operative requirements. The methods of assessment are:

- Interview with Portfolio of Evidence
- Observation with Questions
